Our next camporee in 2022 planning has begun. See you then.



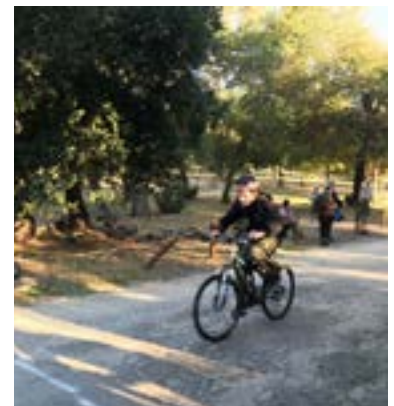
Units that attended Camporee were 649, 651, 668, 669, 679, 700, 702, 709, 722, 731, 768, 799, and 1012 from Jarupa.
