July 19 - 28, 2023



- ❑ What is Jamboree?
  - Scouting's flagship event is one-of-a-kind
  - 15,000 Scouts, leaders, and staff that showcases everything that is great about the BSA
  - Held every four years for participants, volunteers and visitors to experience the best of Scouting
  - Features: Zip line, skate park, ATV, rock climbing, mtn biking, water sports, patch trading and stadium events
  - Monthly jamboree information webinars
  - Register on [jamboree.scouting.org](https://jamboree.scouting.org) (no fee)

- ❑ Council Details - Male and Female Troops
  - Cost - \$3400
  - Includes round trip airfare, ground transportation, food and lodging and council/jamboree gear and t-shirts
  - Personal cost for extra uniform and spending money
  - Travel on 7/18-28 with one night hotel stay prior, no optional tours
  - Initial \$500 non-refundable payment and regular payments on council Doubleknot site
  - Jamboree scholarship available: 7/31 & 12/31 deadlines
  - Eligible BSA youths: 12-18 years old by 7/19/23
  - Eligible BSA older youths: 18-21 years old during jamboree
  - Adult leadership needed: Scoutmaster, ASM and healthcare
  - Required monthly troop meetings and a shakedown camp
