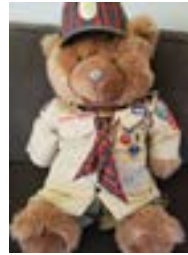

❑ **Council Details - Male and Female Troops**

- Cost - \$3400
- Includes round trip airfare, ground transportation, food and lodging and council/jamboree gear and t-shirts

- Travel on 7/18-28 with one night hotel stay prior, no optional tours
- Initial \$500 non-refundable payment and regular payments on council Doubleknot site
- Jamboree [scholarship](#) available: 7/31 & 12/31 deadlines
- Eligible BSA youths: 12-18 years old by 7/19/23
- Eligible BSA older youths: 18-21 years old during jamboree
