## To participate in the 2024 Troop 709 Mt. Baden-Powell Virtual Peak-A-Thon Fundraiser

- What:** A Peak-A-Thon is similar to a Jog-A-Thon, with Scouts hiking the Double Peak Trail (1040' elevation gain, 2 miles distance) from Discovery Lake to Double Peak up to a maximum of nine times (for a total of 9360', the elevation of Mt Baden-Powell, named after the founder of Scouting). The Peak-A-Thon will raise money for your Troop's Scouting program.
- When:** May 4, 2024 (7AM-5PM)
- Where:** Double Peak Trail in San Marcos, CA (from Discovery Lake to Double Peak Park)
- How:** Upon registration, the Scouts will get their own Peak-A-Thon web page through Rally-Up to solicit and receive donations and pledges (\$x per peak). Scouts will train in the weeks prior to the Peak-A-Thon to get ready for the event. On the day of the event, the Scouts will earn the donations by hiking the Double Peak Trail as many times (up to nine) as they can. At the top of Double Peak Park, they will be transported back down to Discovery Lake where they will be given a health check, given snacks and hydration and, if they choose, start the hike again.
- Cost:** \$40 per participant to help pay for expenses
- Other:** Deadline to register is March 22. All Troops that participate in the event will be required to supply volunteers to assist with the event. Event long sleeve T-shirts will be made available for participants to purchase. Permission slips will need to be signed and collected prior to the event. The "Buddy system" will be followed throughout the day. Lunch will be served. Funds raised will be coordinated through Rally-Up to Troop 709, who will then distribute the funds raised by each Troop directly to their Troop Treasurer. If you think Scouts would not be able to hike up 9360' in a single day, last year Troop 709 had three Scouts accomplish the feat!
