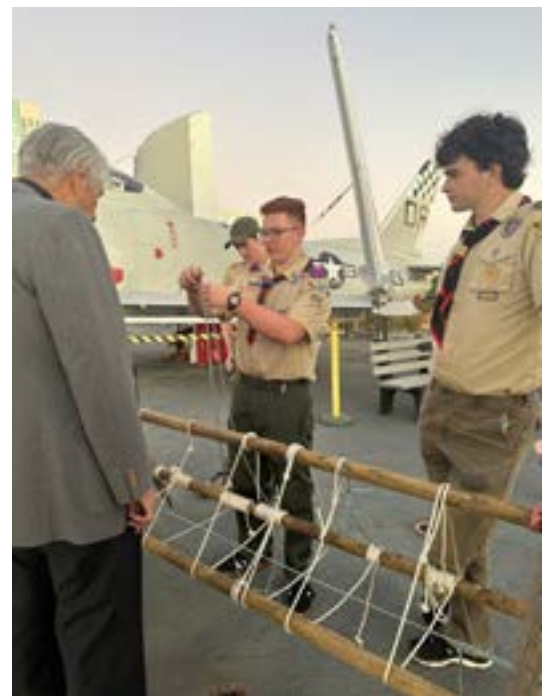

Life to Eagle Training

The Palomar Zone Life to Eagle training is designed to help Life Scouts navigate the next step in their advancement. We will review the requirements for Eagle Scout and provide training to help guide Life Scouts on the Trail to Eagle. In addition, this training will help inform Unit leaders, Eagle Project Coaches and Parents of their roles in supporting the Life Scout in the process.



This training covers the following information, need for a Scout to complete their Eagle Advancement:



1. Eagle Project Proposal, Plan, and Project Report
2. Eagle Rank Application and Attachments
3. Submission of the Eagle application and approval process
4. Eagle Board of Review
